NOTICE OF RACE

Sunday, August 24, 2008

Racing format - Toms River Yacht Club is hosting the 5th annual BBYRA Yacht Club Challenge to determine which club has the best “team” of sailors. This regatta will follow the format for fleet racing based on the Racing Rules of Sailing under Parts 1 - 7 and not appendix D for the team race rules. TRYC members, in conjunction with Ocean County College, will be supplying 30 Tech Dinghies and 15 club 420s for use in this regatta. Each guest club will be supplied two Tech Dinghies and one 420 for participation in the regatta. Each club must field a minimum of 5 sailors with at least one being a woman, but is permitted to field as many sailors as they wish in order to rotate for the various racing conditions which may be encountered. It is suggested that each yacht club supply a support boat(s) (inflatable if possible) from which your extra sailors will be available for rotation depending on conditions and for the club’s spectators and supporters. The committee will attempt to conduct approx. 8 races per fleet during the day. Each team should bring 3 small club burgees to tie to the forestay of their boats. Awards will be determined by the combined scores of the team’s boats.

Eligibility - All participants must be 21 years of age and a member of the participating club. Each club must field a minimum of 5 sailors with one at least one being a woman. Entry form must be postmarked by 8/8/08, invitation only after August 10th clubs outside BBYRA may be invited to participate.

Safety - All participants must wear a USCG approved life jacket.

Fleets - Each club will be supplied the following boats to sail in the scheduled races:

Tech Dinghy #1 – single handed racing, open

Tech Dinghy #2 – double handed racing, open

Club 420 – double handed racing, open

A female skipper or crew must be aboard one of your three boats at all times

(The Tech Dinghy is a 12 foot open boat, with a mainsail, used in college racing)

1st warning gun (racing in front of club) 1030

Lunch at Club, and boat rotation for PM races TBA

1st warning gun - afternoon racing TBA

Awards 1630

Prizes - Prizes will be awarded to the clubs for first, second & third position, with the first place club having bragging rights to the “best on the bay”.
